Biography

Principal Wong is an experienced and dedicated educator, retired as a secondary principal in 2016. Then he serves as the guest lecturer in the Education University of Hong Kong, assisting the programme on Planning Life Education in primary and secondary schools with initiation including professional development workshops for teachers, visits to pioneer local schools with exemplary Life Education programmes, study tours to Taiwan, sharing sessions and school support sessions, all aiming at helping schools to solve and develop strategies or programmes with specific respect to school-based curriculum, student learning/engagement and so forth. In 2017, he was invited as the part-time lecturer to teach the course of “Cases and Workshop for Management Issues in Education” under the MA Program in International Higher Education and Management(IHEM). He is a lifelong learner, received his Ed. D in Educational Management from the Tarlac State University, M. Ed & B. Ed from the Chinese University of Hong Kong, MAELT (Master of Arts in English Language Teaching) from Hong Kong Polytechnic University, MACS (Master of Arts in Christian Studies) from Divinity School of Chung Chi College, Chinese University of Hong Kong and B.A.(Business Administration) from Ottawa University.

He was appointed as the chairman of the Curriculum Development Council from 2013-2016, and assessor of the Chief Executive’s Award for Teaching Excellence in 2013. He was the special reviewer of “New Horizon in Education, The Journal of Education Hong Kong Teachers’ Association (HKTA), 2012. Currently, Dr. Stanley Wong is the Needs Analysis Assessor in the programme for "Preparation for Principalship" run by Hong Kong Baptist University and Education University of Hong Kong respectively. Moreover, he is the tutor for Action Research for Aspiring Principals. From May 2024, Dr. Wong is appointed as the Academic Affairs Adviser by the Affiliated School of JNU for Hong Kong & Macao Students (Dongguan City), he is one of the consultants helping the school to pass the accreditation and turn to be an Approved HKDSE Participating School in the coming year.
