Biography

Dr Zhuang Huijuan is an associate professor and master's degree supervisor at South China Normal University. She is also a part-time doctoral supervisor at Lingnan University. Currently, she serves as the Vice Dean of the International Business School at South China Normal University and the Deputy Director of the Research Base for Cross-border Education Quality Assurance of the China Education Association for International Exchange.
